

Water Security: the Swiss expertise

SWP brings together over **65 member organisations – experts across the sectors and scales**, to share, complement and invent the best solutions to secure sustainable water solutions for all. Swiss water expertise can be clustered as follows:



- IWRM: payment for watershed services, transboundary water manage ment, multistakeholders agreements;
- Sustainable usage: innovative technologies, management of decentralized water systems, business models & behaviour changes;
- Nexus: small hydropower/energy efficiency; recycling waste to value;
- Governance: human rights, water integrity (accountability, transparency etc.)
- Education: e-learning, capacity development, business development.

Innovative cross sectoral solutions for water & energy security

The sustainable management of our precious water resources is a major challenge for the 21st century. The World Economic Forum ranks water as the third largest risk for a global crisis. Water is central for energy, food security and public health.

Therefore SWP promotes integrated solutions for (waste)water, energy and food security management and fosters partnerships across sectors and scale to go beyond a narrow sector approach.

Good examples of these solutions involve the work of research institutes (e.g. Eawag), the private sector (e.g. CSD, Groupe-E, Skat, Nestlé), the government (SDC) and the civil society (Cewas, Sopas, iDE), aiming to increase the food production whilst using less water, energy and ultimately alleviating poverty.
