Our vision

Switzerland has a privileged hydrological situation. However, 82% of the water footprint of Switzerland is imported from less privileged countries.

We want to show solidarity by supporting them in finding solutions to achieve water security for their people and ecosystems.

Driven by our values of solidarity and integrity (i.e. promoting transparency, accountability and participative solutions), we promote the sustainable and equitable use and management of water resources and universal access to safe water and sanitation.

- ◆ **By informing** national and international policy processes.

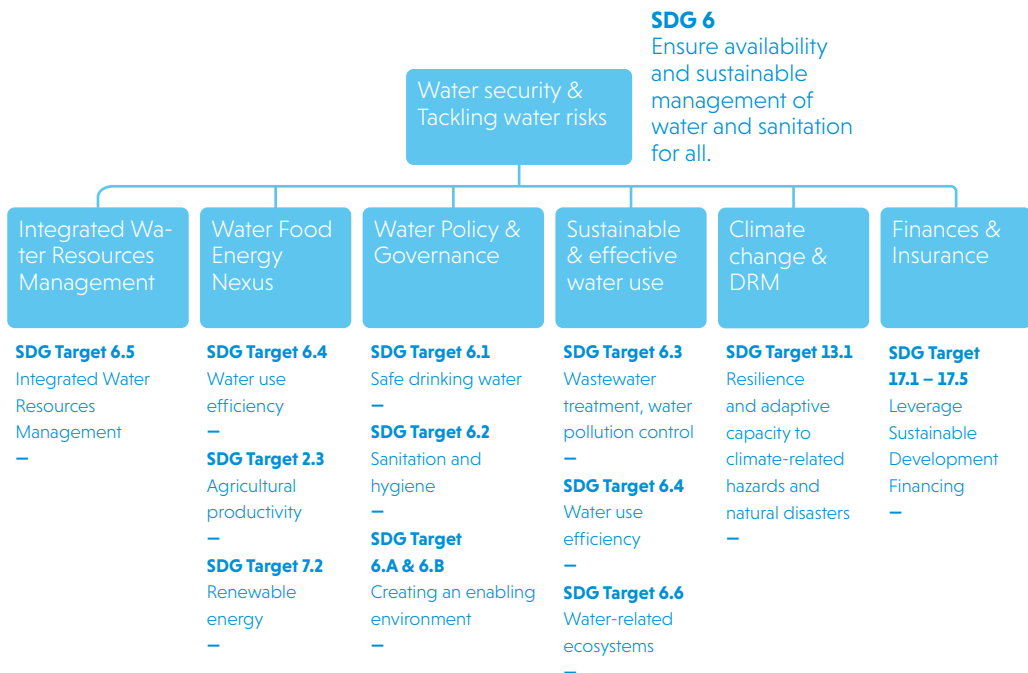

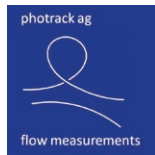
